As we continue to review how to best serve the school community and families, the decision was made to add some committees to the school board. We have four sub-committees: The Executive and Policy Committee, the Operations Committee, the School Safety Committee, and the Strategic Planning Committee.

The Executive and Policy Committee consists of the board chair, vice chair, and secretary. They complete the annual review of the principal and write any policies needed to be presented to the school board for discussion and approval.

The Operations committee, chaired by Tim Tietz, encompasses personal items with the teachers and staff, review of the budget, and marketing ideas and implementation.

The School Safety Committee, chaired by Jennifer Veldboom reviews the safety documents that we need to submit to the DOJ by January 1 of each year. They will also review any current practices for safety and look to implement any other safety measures both short term and long term.

The Strategic Planning Committee, chaired by Sara Decker, will look at our current and future needs along with how best to implement programming for those needs. This will encompass both short term and long term plans.

Please continue to pray for all those serving on the school board and on these committees as well as on all our boards. Thank you for your prayers and support.

The school board will have two parent listening sessions on the following dates: November 14, 2023 at 6:00 pm and April 9, 2024 at 6:00 pm in the school library.
