Hello Members of St. John's Lutheran Church, School, Child Care and Youth,

In light of a desire to be fiscally responsible, the school board and council in conjunction with myself have decided that we are able to cover the additional 5th grade position with the current staff and the addition of Mr. and Mrs. Brey. Mr. Brey will be utilized as the other 5th grade homeroom teacher. Therefore, we will not be extending a call to an additional upper grade teacher for this upcoming school year.

Miss Hess has been offered and accepted a position at her church as the full time youth director. With that said, Mrs. Schraufnagel has agreed to be the full time 4K teacher for the 2024-2025 school year.

We are in need of another teacher to replace Mrs. Schraufnagel. The call committee has interviewed candidates for this position and the council has voted to have a voter's meeting to bring the candidates before the congregation. This Voter's meeting will take place on Monday, May 6, after the service at 6:30 pm.

I ask that you continue to keep the school in your prayers as we continue to grow. We are projected to reach 170 students for the 2024-2025 school year. God continues to grow St. John's Ministry through the Church, Child Care, School and Youth Programs.
